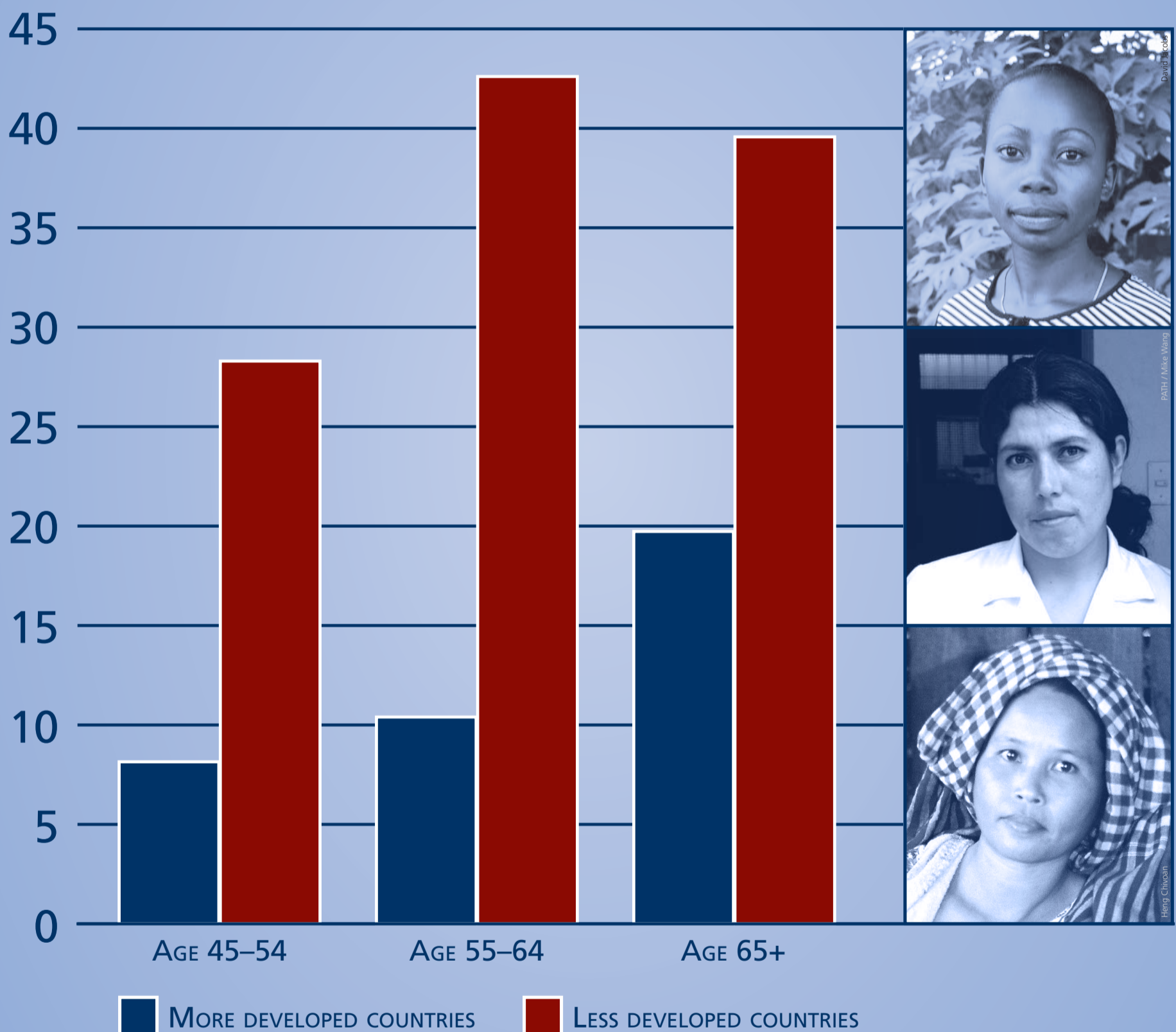


Cervical Cancer

A Heavy Burden for the Developing World

AGE-SPECIFIC CERVICAL CANCER MORTALITY RATES PER 100,000 WOMEN



Many more women die of cervical cancer in the developing world than in wealthier countries. In the industrialized world effective screening programs help identify the cancer in its early stages, when it can be treated. But lack of screening programs in poorer countries means that the disease is not identified until it is too late, resulting in higher mortality.
