Goals: Prepare future trainers to become proficient providers in VIA & Cryotherapy

Participants Learning Objectives

By the end of the training course, the participant will be able to:

- Talk to women about cervical cancer prevention.
- Explain who should have for cervical cancer screening and explain how VIA screens for cervical cancer.
- Explain how cryotherapy treats precancerous cervical lesions.
- Use recommended infection prevention practices to protect the woman, healthcare provider and other healthcare workers.
- Perform a pelvic examination.
- Perform VIA.
- Perform cryotherapy, if indicated.
- Provide followup instructions and counseling after VIA or cryotherapy.
- Provide care and referral, as needed.

Learning Methods

- Illustrated lectures and group discussions.
- Individual and group exercises (case studies, role plays)
- Simulated visual inspection using cervical images, photographs and video footage
- Simulated practice with anatomic (pelvic) and cervical models
- Guided clinical activities (counseling and provision of VIA and cryotherapy) with clients
